March minutes were accepted.

Reports:

• **Treasurer** (Mike Shearin): through the end of March, about \$1,200 behind which is normal during this time of year. Treasurer's report: accepted.

Pastor:

- Attended the Interim Ministers Conference. Subjects of merging vs yoking (sharing a pastor), church vitality meaning people "touched" vs membership and the definition of regular church goers is currently those who go less than weekly.
- o The month included Holy Week & Easter, the Deacons did a good job
- Worked with the search committee and members' needs
- Pastor compensation discussion; PRC should do the evaluation; the conversation of compensation should include the moderator and a trustee representative in the last quarter. PRC will bring the compensation recommendations to the annual meeting for a vote
 - The recommendation to establish an ad-hoc committee which will include the Moderator, a
 Trustee and PRC member to determine the pastor compensation package was passed.
 - A review is still needed to develop the goal setting process. Mike Shearing will help with writing up a policy. The goals for pastor *and* congregation is a two-way conversation.
- Observations: attitudes about the UCC guidelines for compensation among members vary. Discussions need to stay respectful. Mike suggested better transparency on the part of the UCC showing church comparisons.

• C/E:

- Had a good Easter; there were 8 kids for the Easter egg hunt
- The next Food for Thought is still open for time and subject
- o Children's Sunday will be June 10th
- o Blessing of the Animals will be April 29th
- o There are three campers for the Horton Center

Curios:

All is going well. There are enough volunteers and averaging \$100-\$130 per opening

• Missions:

- o There were eight Easter baskets
- One Great Hour of Sharing display is at the back of the church, ends May 6th
- o Diversity books are available at the library and will also be at the school
- Three Great Loves is an ongoing program for the next two years. UCC is collecting stories from churches on "love of neighbor, children and creation"
