- Don Larson spoke with the owner of the gas station building who was open to the possibility of renting it for about \$300 with heat and electricity being extra. It will be shown to Stephanie and Don some evening after the store at Page's Corner closes.
- Dick Burchell's widow, Grace, is in the process of making repairs to the Curios building. The combination of the lockbox was given to Mrs. Burchell. It appears her intention is to keep the building, meaning Curios may not have to move. Items in the storage area will be moved to Bill and Anne Zeller's barn temporarily while repairs are done.
- Stephanie and Jackie have opened the shop to individuals who want a "private" viewing of items for sale and will continue to do so. Also considering another yard sale in the spring.
