Reports:

• Treasurer: Report accepted

- o There is a deficit of \$1225
- o Statements were sent out to those who pledge. The stewardship committee helped with the mailing.
- o Pledges are down
- Trustees: Committee budgets are needed by December 12th

Pastor Chris:

- Met with Dan Andrus of St. Johns regarding the Thanksgiving Day service. Pastor Chris will participate in the service. Keep in mind the Dan is a good connection to St. Johns
- Met with Robert Vodra and will be available to him as needed.
- Roger and Gwen Rice have transferred their membership from Lee Church Congregational and will be accepted into DCC next Sunday, the 25th

Missions:
